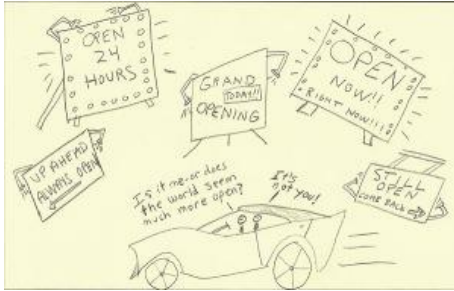


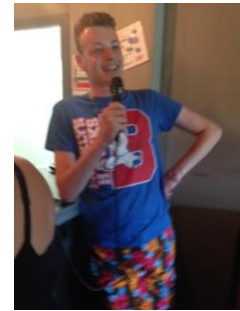


Newsletter September 2014 – from Tina and the directors
